The Hampshire Regional YMCA offers full-day & half-day programs on most early dismissal days, professional days, school holidays, and vacation weeks.

For your convenience, half-day programs are held right at your child's school and will include a healthy snack.

The host site for All Days Out program is Jackson Street Elementary School. Registration is first come, first served as space allows.

# RATES AND REGISTRATION

- YMCA programs are fully licensed by the MA Department of Early Education and Care (EEC).
- Enrollment forms are available at the YMCA, and on our website ([www.hrymca.org](http://www.hrymca.org)). Registration for School Age Child Care (SACC) is done in person at the HRYMCA Welcome Center, located at 286 Prospect St. in Northampton.
- Monthly rates are calculated for the 10-month school year, with a discount for those with a YMCA Household Membership.
- We offer a 5% discount for a second child enrolled in the program.
- We accept state subsidized vouchers.
- We have added two new positions to our SACC team with funding we have received through the Department of Early Education and Care, which will support STEAM and Character Development units that will reinforce our core values.
