The HRYMCA Camp Prospect offers an ideal blend of camp activities, providing a healthy summer experience for your child. A day at Camp Prospect will include camp games, physical challenges, swimming, arts and crafts projects, singing songs and staying active.

Our Olympic and World Cup themed weeks include a focus on playing traditional camp games and introducing sports at a variety of ability levels. Our Ninja Warrior themed weeks will have our gymnasium transformed into a different obstacle course every day, giving campers the ability to challenge themselves as they develop their skills and agility.

Campers will develop a sense of belonging regardless of age, experience or ability. #### THEMED WEEKS

During our Olympics and World Cup themed weeks, campers will be participating in a wide variety of activities and games where they will able to earn points for the country they represent. Campers will have a country assigned to their group and have opportunities to learn about their country's culture. During Olympics weeks, we will highlight the many different sports that are played during the summer games and play our own versions of these games for them to perfect. During World Cup weeks, we will still play a wide variety of games and activities, with additional opportunities to learn and play soccer. No previous soccer experienced is required to enjoy these weeks of Camp Prospect.

Our Ninja Warrior weeks focus on giving our campers opportunities to enhance their skills in balance, agility, climbing, and coordination. Our gymnasium will be transformed with a full obstacle course, utilizing equipment that keeps them moving dynamically while challenging themselves. We also have a Ninja Warrior Cage with many different attachments, including a floating beam, monkey bars, sliding rings, and more. Lastly, we challenge our campers with the Warp Wall, an 8 feet tall curved wall for them to run and see how far they can get to the top!

All weeks of Camp Prospect include time for daily swimming, arts & crafts, board games, and camp songs.

A session at Camp Norwich offers many exciting opportunities for growth, joy, and discovery in a well-supervised small-group setting. Our Camp Norwich program takes place at a beautiful facility encompassing 175 acres of lake, woods, and fields in the foothills of the Berkshires. Groups of 5 to 13 same-aged campers and two counselors spend the day together.

Inclusion in these groups encourages children to experience new and diverse age-appropriate activities. These activities are tools to help campers develop self-confidence, creativity, teamwork, appreciation of the outdoors, and pride in themselves and their newly acquired skills. Camp Norwich is proud of its quality staff members, who provide expert leadership, guidance, and friendship. Our staff helps each camper reach their full potential, facilitating skill development, and social and emotional growth. Many friendships and special memories await you at Camp Norwich. Come explore the Norwich adventure with us!

At Camp Norwich, we believe in taking care of the camper in spirit, mind, and body. Our camp programs have been designed to ensure the health and safety of our campers.

Camper groups are made up of 5-13 children in the same age group. Each of these groups belong to an age-specific unit that shares common activities while receiving instruction to help develop a wide range of skills.

#### **EXPLORERS** Entering grades K-2

The Explorers group is a great introduction to summer camp for our youngest children. Each day of camp is filled with excitement and new experiences! Daily schedules emphasize routine and provide a balance between active and quiet, sports and culture, and group and individual activities. In our small-group environment, children receive the extra support and encouragement they need to feel at home. During each 2-week session, there will be a Family Night which includes picnic dinner, skits, and songs with your camper and their counselor, ending with s'mores at our campfire circle.

#### **ADVENTURERS** Entering grades 3-5

This challenging and exciting program for new and experienced day campers not only provides daily cabin group activities but also encourages campers to pursue their own interests by participating in a special program area each day. Program areas allow campers to develop new skills and confidence under the guidance of knowledgeable and supportive instructors. During each 2-week session, there will be a Family Night which includes picnic dinner, skits, and songs with your camper and their counselor, ending with s'mores at our campfire circle.

#### **TRAILBLAZERS** Entering grades 6-8

Empowering youth to assume more responsibility is the emphasis of this specially designed program. Each session allows campers to experience lessons in group dynamics, creative problem-solving, environmental awareness, and program planning. Traditional camp activities such as boating, swimming, crafts, and sports round out the total experience. This unit's campers participate in all program areas each week in order to master skills and spend time mentoring younger campers. During each 2-week session, there will be a Family Night which includes picnic dinner, skits, and songs with your camper and their counselor, ending with s'mores at our campfire circle.

#### CIT PROGRAM Entering grades 9 and 10 | Two, 4-week sessions for Teens

The goal of Camp Norwich's pilot CIT program is to transition campers into counselors, creating responsible and independent young leaders who can contribute positively to camp and their community. Being a CIT means committing to learning and growing personally, professionally, individually, and as a team. The creativity, responsibility, and enthusiasm needed to work at camp will provide CITs with in-demand job skills for any future

career. CITs should be prepared to step out of their comfort zone and be willing to lead, learn, and work with a variety of ages providing support to both campers as well as camp staff.

The CIT program is a four-week commitment and has an application process that requires essay questions, two letters of recommendation, and an onsite group interview at Camp Norwich. The CIT application deadline is Friday, March 8th, 2024.

#### **PROGRAM AREAS - FOR ALL CAMPERS**

TEAM BUILDING: Campers will enjoy fun team-bonding and team-building activities on the ground and on our newly renovated low ropes challenge course. Campers will work together to solve puzzles, brainstorm solutions, and collaborate on different aspects of team-building. Our low ropes course offers additional elements to team-building as campers work together to combat the Whale Watch, Traverse Wall, Wild Woosey, and more!

PERFORMING ARTS: Campers gain performance skills and confidence as they work together to prepare and present a production that is in the realm of music, dance, and theater. Campers learn about stage presence, voice, choreography, movement, scenery, costume design, forms of dance, and music in a fun atmosphere.

BOATING: Throughout the session, campers develop competency in basic boating skills. Our staff teaches proper boating techniques and safety in our kayaks, canoes, and rowboats.

ARTS AND CRAFTS: Our Art Specialist helps develop the interests and abilities of campers who love to work with materials and be creative. Campers paint, draw, make jewelry, weave, and work with a variety of other materials as they learn new and exciting skills.

OUTDOOR LIVING SKILLS: Campers spend time in the woods as they take hikes, learn to tie knots, build fires, use a compass, identify wild edible plants, cook outdoors, and build a shelter. This is a great program for the outdoor enthusiast.

ATHLETICS: Campers take part in sports such as basketball, soccer, touch football, volleyball, baseball, and other activities.

FISHING: Campers will learn the basic techniques to catch and release fish for fun! Campers will spend time casting into beautiful Lake Norwich for the five varieties of fish found within our lake.

ARCHERY: For the target enthusiast, here's a chance to develop basic archery skills. Campers will learn fundamentals such as stance, draw and release, as well as perfect follow-through.





#### **FAMILY NIGHTS**

One of the most memorable events of camp sessions 2–4 is our Family Nights. This is a time when campers can tour their family around camp and showcase their accomplishments from the session. The night includes a family picnic dinner, activities around camp, and time around the campfire which includes campers' skits and songs. We will require family members to show a valid photo ID upon entrance to this event to ensure the safety of all of our campers. You must sign your camper out at the lodge upon arrival. Please note that families will be required to RSVP for this event on the week prior for planning purposes.

**CAMP FEES:** All costs associated with camp (with the exception of bus transportation to Camp Norwich and early care for Camp Prospect) are covered in one fee. This includes programs, family events, and camp T-Shirt.

**SIBLING DISCOUNT:** Siblings who register for equal amounts of weeks/sessions of camp are eligible to receive a 10% discount for second sibling. Not applicable to FA recipients.

TAX CREDIT: Your YMCA Day Camp Fees may qualify for a Childcare Tax Credit. Contact your local IRS office for details.

**REFUND POLICY:** All payments, minus the \$105 non-refundable down payment, are refundable prior to May 14, 2024. After May 14, 2024, refunds are available upon receiving written notice from the camper's physician that would exclude the camper from more than half of the camp session.

#### **DEADLINES**

**PAYMENT DEADLINE:** All payments are due in full by <u>May 15, 2024</u> for all sessions. If your camp balance is not paid in full by <u>May 15, 2024</u>, your camper's sessions will be automatically forfeited and there will be no refund. If space is available after <u>May 15, 2024</u>, payment in full is due at the time of registration.

**CAMP DOCUMENTS DEADLINE:** All camper health information, physicals (within 15 months of camp session), and immunization forms must be entered online in CampDoc within 30 days after you receive your email from CampDoc or by June 15, 2024, whichever is earlier.

**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:** The HRYMCA strives to make the camp experience accessible to all young people through our Financial Assistance (FA) program and our generous donors. Please contact the Welcome Center for application information. In order to evaluate Financial Assistance eligibility, we require **last year's 1040 tax form, and two consecutive paystubs along with a Financial Assistance application.**

#### **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (FA) POLICIES:**

- Applying for FA with non-refundable down payment at the time of registration:
  - You can choose to pay the \$105.00 non-refundable down payment for each session of camp while you wait for the eliqibility of your Financial Aid for camp.
  - This option will secure your camper's spot.
  - If FA is approved, and you wish to secure the financial assistance rate, acceptance and activation of your award must be completed within 30 days of receiving the FA Award Letter.
- Applying for FA without non-refundable down payment at the time of registration:
  - You can choose not to pay the \$105.00 non-refundable down payment for each session of camp while you wait for the eligibility of your Financial Aid for camp.
  - The submission of the application does not reserve a spot for your camper.
  - If FA is approved, and you wish to secure the financial assistance rate, acceptance and activation of your award must be completed within 30 days of receiving the FA Award Letter.

#### **OTHER FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (FA) POLICIES:**

- FA must be applied for within 30 days of registering for camp.
- Families are now eligible to apply for up to four weeks of summer camp per child.
- FA does not apply towards Camp Norwich bus fee.
- Sibling Discount cannot be combined with campers receiving FA.

# HAMPSHIRE REGIONAL YMCA SUMMER CAMP 2024 CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICIES

#### **CANCELLATIONS:**

If you have registered your camper for one of our HRYMCA Day Camps and choose to cancel your session <u>PRIOR</u> to the <u>May 14, 2024</u>, down payment deadline, refunds will be granted minus the <u>\$105.00</u> non-transferable, non-refundable down payment.

If you choose to cancel your session <u>AFTER</u> the <u>May 14, 2024</u>, down payment deadline, refunds are available upon receiving written notice from the camper's physician and only in cases of camper having extreme illness or injury (excluding camper from more than half of the camp session and approval from the camp director) Refunds will be granted minus the <u>\$105.00</u> non-transferable, non-refundable down payment.

\*All cancellations must be requested via email to Lisa.Candito@hrymca.org. You will receive an email confirmation that your request has been processed.

#### **TRANSFERS:**

If you are requesting to transfer your camper out of a session into another <u>available session</u>, you may transfer between any of our HRYMCA camps and all money paid towards camp will be transferred into the new session requested.

The deadline to request a transfer is <u>May 1, 2024</u>. After the deadline of May 1, 2024, the non-refundable deposit is no longer transferable. Requests for transfers after May 1, 2024, <u>are not quaranteed</u>.

#### **PAYMENT DUE DATES:**

If your camp balance is not paid in full by <u>May 15, 2024</u>, your camper's spot will be automatically forfeited and there will be no refunds
